Real Reenactors Fight On Both Sides

Regulation

1.Basic principles

These rules are not a basis for discussion. There will be no debates along the lines of "But there has been...". These rules are not an end in themselves, but for the many participants who put a lot of energy and effort into their presentation. These rules apply to everyone, whether beginner or veteran, after all these are the minimum requirements. If you don't like these rules..., well there are many other hobby events without such rules; better go there.

2. Respect

We treat every participant with respect and expect the same for us without restriction. Respect also includes not taking every opportunity to skirt the rules.

3. Participants

Every participant is a reenactor, i.e. has a recognisable and defined representation; this can be civilian or military.

4. Military representation

Every military reenactor is part of a military structure, i.e. a company, a battery, a squadron or is a legitimate part of a staff. If there are no contacts, we will be happy to establish them. Individual "independent" soldiers are not permitted, and the number of guns is limited to the extent that each gun must be manned by at least 6 men and a balanced ratio between Union and Confederate is achieved.

5. Civilian representation

A separate camp area (civilian camp) is offered for the civilian performers. The purpose is to offer civilian performers a space for activities and representation. The civilian camp is not a "catch basin" or retreat for soldiers who are uncomfortable in the military camp. The same guidelines apply in the civilian camp as for the entire event

6. Clothing

The clothing (including shoes) of the participants (military and civilian) corresponds to the time and place depicted in terms of cut and fabric/material (e.g. no Indian scouts, no trappers)

7. Visible anachronisms

Visible anachronisms will not be accepted at any time. These include in particular (not an exhaustive list):-Modern packaging of any kind (including bottles)-Cooler bags-Filter cigarettes, lighters (gas or petrol)-Any electric light (including LED) or electrical appliances

8. Responsibilities

Each unit leader or leader of the presentation group is responsible for the implementation/enforcement of these rules and initiates necessary improvements or remedies. If it becomes necessary to use the householder's rights in this context, a representative of the organiser will be available

9. Taverns

The tavern(s) will close at midnight if a battle display is planned for the next day

10. Driving on the grounds

Driving on the grounds is not permitted between Friday 15:00 and Sunday 06:00. The organiser reserves the right to limit access in general if the ground conditions require it

11. Uncertainties

If anything is unclear, please ask beforehand. We are not keen to send anyone home - but we must and will do so for all those who adhere to the rules in the interests of all participants f you have any questions, please contact info@4thtennessee.de
